In the final term we ran all over North Haven, reaping the rewards from our heavy rotations in the first half. North Haven had no response to our fresh legs and we piled on another four in the last, to run out solid winners, 12-10-82 to 7-2-44.

With three key targets up forward we were reasonably confident with our set up, however it was Harry Bilyk who managed to sneak under their guard, popping up for six goals in a best on ground performance. Harry has a good set of hands and knows where to position himself, a very dangerous combination at this level.

Seb Richards was solid in the middle, providing plenty of grunt together with Hunty, as well as a strong appetite for the physical side of the game.

Will Noblett was a late inclusion and was thrown in down back, doing a wonderful job. Often leaving his man to help cover, he halved a number of contests and often won the ball and ran it out of the back lines well. Will Farminer had another solid game at CHB and together with Matty Davis and Mark McGregor we were rarely beaten in the defensive half.

Trinne played his first game in the Ds and showed what a great work rate can do, while Duffield and Hill continued their great starts to the season providing plenty of run and a fearless attack on the contest.
