One of their other brothers, Steve, never played, but was involved off the field and in season 2000, along with Mick, Nick & Tim they were awarded the Headmaster's Award for Services On and Off the Field.

Over the next few seasons his footy skills were fine-tuned and he became an integral part of the A's side culminating in the 2004 premiership. He has since gone on to play in two more premierships; 2009 B Grade and 2011 C Grade and won the Division 8 Medal last season.

Over his career he has often filled the role of "Fitness Coach" in both an official and unofficial capacity and being one of the "Park 9 key holders" as often the first and last to leave. Along the way his other achievements at the Club are;
