

Mark Standley was educated at Prince Alfred College between 1974 and 1978 and was a true "Red Man".

Mark was a distinguished 'backman' for the school's 1st XVIII team in both 1977 and 1978 and, between bouts of and periods of recovery from illness, he played 122 games for the PAOCFC between 1980 and 1989.

In recognition of his solid on-field achievements at the club, Mark was awarded a life membership of the PAOCFC in 1987 and he won a coach's award in 1988.

PAOCFC committee member Chris Day was with Mark on Sunday the 29th of May when, after a long (though spasmodic) battle with brain cancer, Mark passed away peacefully and without pain.
